



SOPORIFIC SUDOKU



This puzzle takes a standard sudoku and makes it more confusing. Each symbol can have one of six different NUMBERS (1-6), SHAPES (square, diamond, triangle, pentagon, hexagon, circle), COLOURS (black, orange, green, blue, pink, grey) and FILLS (unfilled, completely filled, top/bottom/left/right half filled) Each row, column and bold region in the sudoku has one of each kind.

When the grid has been filled, take the symbols rotationally 180° opposite - i.e. the symbol in the position you end up in if the grid is rotated so it is upside down (1 on the top left maps on to 6 in the bottom right). These symbols are:



Using A=1 to Z=26, this spells out COMA, the answer to this puzzle, which has now sent you to sleep.
